

The NEW 24 Litre JAGUAR



ENGINE. Six cylinder 2-4 litre Jaguar XK series with 70° twin overhead camshafts driven by 2-stage duplex roller chain; 83 mm. bore x 76-5 mm. stroke; 2483 c.c. developing 112 b.h.p.; cooling by pump with by-pass thermostat control. Compression ratio 7 or 8:1; twin Solex carburetters.

TRANSMISSION. Four-speed synchromesh gearbox. Centrally positioned gear-shift lever. 9" single dry plate clutch. Hardy Spicer propeller shaft.

SUSPENSION. Independent front suspension by coil springs and wishbones. Rear by cantilever half-elliptic springs. Girling telescopic dampers front and rear.

BRAKING. Powerful Lockheed "Brakemaster" serve-assisted brakes with 11½" diameter drums. Friction lining area 156-8 sq. in.

STEERING. Burman re-circulating ball type steering with 17" diameter adjustable steering wheel.

FUEL SUPPLY. S.U. electric fuel pump. Tank capacity 13-5 imperial gallons. ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT. Lucas 12-volt 51 amp-hour battery. Double dipper headlamps. Wing lamps incorporating flashers. Stop light, reverse light, panel light, interior light, twin blended-note horns, screen wipers.

INSTRUMENTS. 5in. diameter, 120 m.p.h. speedometer; ammeter; oil pressure gauge; water temperature gauge; fuel gauge.

BODY. Full 5-seater, all steel, constructed integrally with frame, fully adjustable front bucket seats, upholistered in finest Vaumol leather over Dunlopillo. Three cubby holes, polished walnut instrument panel and interior garnishings, ashtrays, and sun visors.

LUGGAGE ACCOMMODATION. Very large luggage locker of 13-5 cubic feet capacity.

WHEELS & TYRES. Pressed steel bolt-on disc wheels fitted with Dunlop 6-40 x 15 tyres.

SPECIAL EQUIPMENT MODEL

To the motorist demanding the utmost in specification, the Special Equipment Model will make instant appeal. Identified by its handsome Jaguar radiator mascot, the Special Equipment Model is fitted with an interior heater and padded centre armrest in the rear compartment. Windscreen washers offer added safety, and twin foglamps, individually adjustable, are fitted. The interior lights are operated automatically by the doors and a five-inch diameter engine revolution counter, electric clock and cigar lighter are added to the instrument panel equipment. The already high finish of the engine is further enhanced by brilliantly polished black vitreous enamelled twin exhaust manifolds.

The new 2'4 litre Jaguar will be publicly exhibited for the first time at the Earls Court Motor Show on October 19th, and thereafter in the showrooms of Jaguar Distributors and Dealers who will gladly supply literature and information.

Allied to these characteristics are superb roadholding and braking qualities inseparable from all Jaguar cars.
