Wherever an XJ6, Sovereign or XJ12 is driven it will perform with distinction.







an exceptionally balanced combination of power, torque, smoothness and economy.


The 3.2 and 4.0 litre AJ16 units are of allalloy construction and 24-valve design. The cylinder block is

torque. On-plug coils give new levels of accuracy to the ignition








A formidable range of theft deterrents includes visible VIN (vehicle identification number), engine immobiliser, deadlocking, flush interior door locks, locking wheel nuts and accessory features such as glass etching and a tracker system. As an added deterrent Alpha Dots are also fitted as standard. These microscopic particles, bearing the VIN and concealed in large numbers throughout the car, are virtually impossible to locate and remove.


Each car has a unique,
electronically tagged ignition key which is
virtually impossible to copy. The key
automatically arms the engine immobiliser
on withdrawal from the ignition. It can then
be used to lock, deadlock, set the alarm
and close the windows and sunroof.










It seems to sit particularly low. Wheels and tyres are wide and aggressive. One piece, colour-keyed bumpers give a harmonious, integrated look.

rom an engineering standpoint, the driving dynamics of the Classic range are expressed not by the svelte exterior, but by the charts, graphs and performance curves which prove what only experience behind the wheel will demonstrate.

That in all guises – XJ6, Sovereign and XJ12 – the Jaguar saloons have exceptional performance, flexibility and joie de vivre.

The XJ6 and Sovereign offer a choice of the 3.2 or 4.0 litre, AJ16 engines. All alloy, 24 valve and electronically managed,



both engines have revisions to the cylinder head, cylinder block, camshaft, pistons, throttle system, manifolds and valve gear.

The result – greater efficiency, improved economy, inspired acceleration and an even greater maximum speed where conditions and legislation allow. Meanwhile, the 6.0 litre V12 is one of the most authoritative power units ever installed in a motor car.

As mentioned earlier the engine management system matches the legislation which Jaguar – as a truly international car – must meet in its most demanding markets. Furthermore every function is computer monitored and the inherent technology means your Jaguar dealer can generate a computer print-out for fast and efficient diagnosis.

f the overall impression of the Classic range is one of presence and purpose, then a closer look reveals details which reinforce the credibility of the cars' design.

The deep, thickly carpeted boot has ample capacity to carry two sets of golf clubs or the Jaguar Collection Luggage, as well as the optional CD auto changer and premium sound amplifier.

Even the boot lid has a plethora of features – it can be opened electronically from both inside the car by a switch and outside, using a push button. There are two lamps and a warning triangle is standard on Sovereign and XJ12.

Regardless of the load you choose to carry or tow, the optional ride-levelling suspension system will maintain the car's even disposition at all times. In any event, there is a four position headlamp leveller controlled from the dashboard. Four intensely powerful halogen headlamps are supported by faired in twin fog lamps and optional power wash.

The sun roof has a tilt feature, a deflector to minimise noise and has been designed to minimise intrusion into headroom.

The wheels add distinction to each model in the Classic range. The XJ6 and Sovereign feature 7" x 16" rims, while the sporting suspension of the XJ12 is best suited by larger 8" x 16" wheels. Alloy versions are now "diamond turned", for a gleaming, highly polished effect.

All around exterior detailing such as colour keyed side body moldings, door mirrors and handles and subtle yet distinctive badging all emphasise the care with which the Classic range has been designed and built.






State of the art technology distinguish the instruments and control systems which are placed in this luxurious environment. The facia switch pack has improved ergonomics, the instrument panel has a full range of instrument warning lamps – including those for airbags and traction control. The LCD display is completely comprehensive.

What is more, Sovereign and XJ12 models have highly sophisticated driver controls for exterior mirrors, steering wheel and the seat position – the latter switches are discreetly designed into the seat squab itself. The electronic memory logs your ideal position for seat height, tilt, rake and headrest, for steering column position, for exterior mirror angles – and not just for you but for two other settings. Your personal key transmitter tells the car who is about to drive it. Appropriate adjustments are automatically effected, as you stroll to the car.

he Classic range has a choice of transmission – in every case crisp, fluent and seamless. Standard in the XJ6 is a 5-speed manual gearbox, with a 4-speed automatic as an option which is standard on Sovereign models. With 4,0 litre engines the 4-speed automatic also features electronic control, so that you can opt for 'sport' or 'normal' mode at the touch of a button. This specification also serves the mighty power of the 6.0 litre XJ12.

The console also contains the in-car entertainment system – one of the most advanced of its kind. The radio has sophisticated RDS, which tracks local radio stations for relevant traffic news while you are listening to other stations, or to the cassette or CD. As your speed increases, the volume does too, automatically. Eight speakers are built in to doors, front pillars and rear shelf. As an option for dedicated music buffs, we have designed a premium system with international audio specialists Harman Kardon, which includes nine speakers and a 240 watt eight channel amplifier.



When matched to the optional 6 disc CD autochanger, the premium system provides a powerful audio experience.

The atmosphere of quiet authority extends, naturally, to the atmosphere within the car itself. One of the most advanced climate control systems yet devised is fitted to Sovereign and XJ12. Silent, efficient, ducted to give optimum comfort at foot, face – indeed, every level in any climate. The controls, however, are refreshingly uncomplicated. Furthermore, there's a solar sensor – which automatically compensates for the effects of direct sunlight.

Perfect living conditions are ideal driving conditions too.


